Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Cairo

Pyramids resort by Jaz

Welcome to Egypt! Arrive at Cairo International Airport and meet the tour representative who will assist with the immigration process, passport control and baggage collection. Travel to the hotel in Cairo to freshen up before receiving a brief overview of the tour from your Egyptologist tour guide who will accompany the group for the duration of the trip. If your flight arrives early enough, join the Grand Egyptian Museum tour to walk among Tutankhamun's complete tomb collection in a dramatic architectural landmark.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Sphinx - Sakkara

Breakfast Pyramids resort by Jaz

This morning, visit the Giza pyramid complex! See the Great Pyramid of Giza, the Pyramid of Khafre, the Pyramid of Menkaure, and the Great Sphinx. Next, see the unique step pyramid of Zoser in Sakkara. Complete the day with an optional sound and light show at the Giza Pyramids or a dinner cruise along the Nile River! Please note: The flight to Aswan is either on Sunday evening or Monday morning depending on availability.

Day 3: Aswan - Philae Temple - Nile Cruise

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner M/S Nile Symphony

Catch an early-morning flight to Aswan. Arrive and board the 5-star Nile cruise ship. The adventures begin with a boat ride to Agilkia Island to explore the Temple of Isis at Philae. Built during the Ptolemaic Kingdom (305 BC to 30 BC), the temple is dedicated to Isis, one of Egypt's oldest goddesses! Enjoy the first night aboard the cruise.

Day 4: Kom-Ombo - Nile Cruise

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner M/S Nile Symphony

This morning, join the optional excursion to Abu Simbel, two massive temples in southern Egypt. The tour continues with a visit to the Temple of Kom-Ombo, a unique 'double' temple dedicated to crocodile god Sobek and falcon god Haroeris (Horus). After some

time to explore, continue to Luxor, where the tour will spend the night on board the cruise ship.

Day 5: Luxor - Karnak Temple - Nile Cruise

 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  M/S Nile Symphony

After breakfast, tour the East Bank of Luxor. Experience the incredible Karnak Temple Complex which was part of the ancient city of Thebes. Dedicated to ram-headed god Amun, it offers a vast mix of temples, chapels, statues and obelisks. Next, explore Luxor Temple, a place of worship dedicated to three gods: Amun, his wife Mut and his son Khons.

Day 6: Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut - Hurghada

This morning, tour the West Bank of Luxor. Visit the world-famous Valley of the Kings and explore tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs, including Tutankhamen. Then, experience the Temple of Hatshepsut, a mortuary temple of Egypt's only Pharaoh Queen. Next, visit the great Colossi of Memnon. Finally, travel to Hurghada for a two-night stay at an all-inclusive Red Sea resort!

Day 7: Hurghada: Free Day
