Day 1: Start of tour in Amsterdam

En route, visit Pärnu, a scenic Estonian resort town, and explore Latvia's seaside town of Saulkrasti before a sombre visit to the Latvian Military Cemetery, dedicated to the soldiers who fought in WWI. Later, arrive in Riga. Embark on a walking tour to discover Riga's buzzing atmosphere and spellbinding Art Nouveau architecture.

Day 12: **Riga - Hill of Crosses - Trakai - Vilnius**

Lithuania is calling today! The first stop is the Hill of Crosses - a pilgrimage site loaded with around 100,000 crosses. Next stop is Trakai, home to an exquisite brick-built island castle. Later, arrive in Vilnius, Lithuania's capital, and enjoy an orientation tour. During your free time, discover the UNESCO-listed Old Town and the self-proclaimed artists' republic of Užupis.
